### ***What's Involved?***

A willingness to make a positive environmental impact to your property.

### ***What are the Eligible Projects?***

Any project that can improve, maintain or protect water quality, quantity, and/or aquatic or terrestrial habitat is eligible for funding. Projects must also incorporate some aspect of public awareness or education. This may be in the form of promotional or interpretive signage, public participation in the implementation of the project or tours that showcase achievements.

### ***Who is Eligible for Funding?***

Residents or groups within the Town of Cobourg and within the Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority are eligible for funding. This includes the watersheds of Cobourg Creek, Midtown Creek, Brook Creek and Massey Creek.

### ***When Does Funding Occur?***

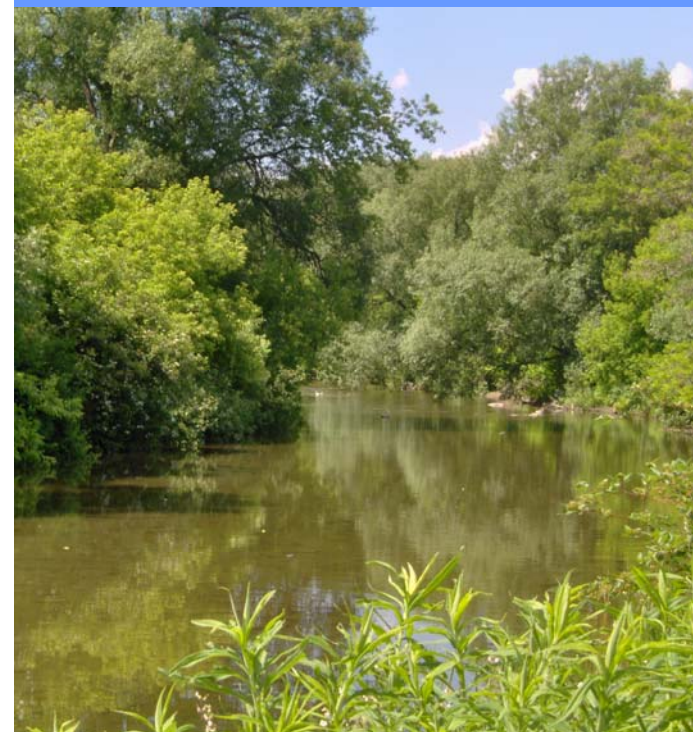

## *Funding Caps and Cost Sharing*

<b>Project Category</b>	<b>Example Project Type</b>	<b>Cost-Share Proportion</b>	<b>Grant Cap</b>
Backyard Best Management Practices	Water conservation tools Native land cover, tree or shrub planting	Up to 50%	\$1,000
Habitat Rehabilitation, Enhancement or Protection (REP)	Stream and/or riparian REP Fish and wildlife habitat REP	Up to 50%	\$3,000
Community Projects	School yard environmental projects Community group projects	Up to 50%	\$2,000
Well Management	Decommissioning of unused wells Well upgrades/improvement (if residents can not be hooked to municipal services)	Up to 50%	\$1,000
Erosion Control	Streambank erosion or stabilization structures	Up to 50%	\$2,500
Other	Any other project brought forward by the applicant	Up to 50%	\$2,500
