



GIS Technician

The Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority has a position open for a GIS Technician to support our team with web based GIS, Imagery and Elevation data management and GIS data management.

Location:

This position will be working out of the administrative office in Port Hope located on the corner of Hwys. 28 and 401.

Qualifications:

- degree or equivalent educational background from a recognized university or community college in GIS
- applicants should have up to 5 years related experience
- a thorough knowledge of ArcGIS Server, including administration and application development
- a working knowledge of ArcGIS Desktop, ArcSDE and MS SQL server
- knowledge of orthophotography and elevation data is required
- remote sensing and mapping skills normally applied to resource management are required
- a knowledge of Municipal and Environmental GIS will be an asset
- a knowledge of GPS and Total Station survey techniques will be an asset
- applicants will be required to perform some work outside
- applicants should have excellent communication skills, both oral and written and ability to multi-task
- the successful applicant must be able to adapt to an environment of change and work well independently as well as in a team environment
- a valid Province of Ontario drivers licence is also required

Duties:

Involvement in programs of the Authority including:

- provide revised mapping and analysis of natural hazard features
- imagery and elevation data support to project team
- development and maintenance of baseline databases
- maintenance of GIS system including knowledge of operating systems and software
- provide support to data collection team and analysis of watershed hydrology, fisheries, groundwater and ecology through GIS interpretation
