



The Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority (GRCA) is accepting applications for the following position:

Summer Camp Assistant Teacher
Approx. 30 hours per week
July 2 – August 31, 2018
(with the exception of August 6 – 10, when there is no camp offered)

The Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority operates the Nature Nuts Summer Day Camp program, located in Port Hope, Ontario. Nature Nuts is an eight-week environmental based summer camp program offered to children aged 6 to 14. Each week of camp has a specific theme relating to the environment.

This is an excellent opportunity to work in a varied and active program with highly motivated and enthusiastic campers using the outdoors as a classroom.

Location:

This position will be working out of the Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority Millennium Building located on the corner of County Road 28 and Hwy 401 in Port Hope.

Application Criteria:

1. This position is restricted to students 15-30 years of age on the first day of employment
2. Applicants must be a resident of Ontario
3. Applicants must be eligible to work in Canada
4. Applicants must be currently enrolled in school full-time and intend to return to school full-time in the fall
5. Applicants must possess a valid Ontario driver's licence and a current police check, including vulnerable sector screening

Responsibilities:

- Teaching and supervising children 6-14 years old in small and large group settings
- Inventory and purchasing of camp supplies, as needed
- Interaction with campers' parents and guardians
- Developing and implementing new lessons and games for each week of camp
- Other duties, as assigned

Qualifications:

- Applicants should have excellent communication and organizational skills
- Preference will be given to applicants with camp counsellor experience or teaching experience in the field of conservation education, the natural sciences and /or outdoor education
- Applicants must be able to work with a variety of ages in small and large group environments
- The successful applicant must be able to adapt to an environment of change and work well independently as well as in a team environment
